### FROM THE DIRECTOR



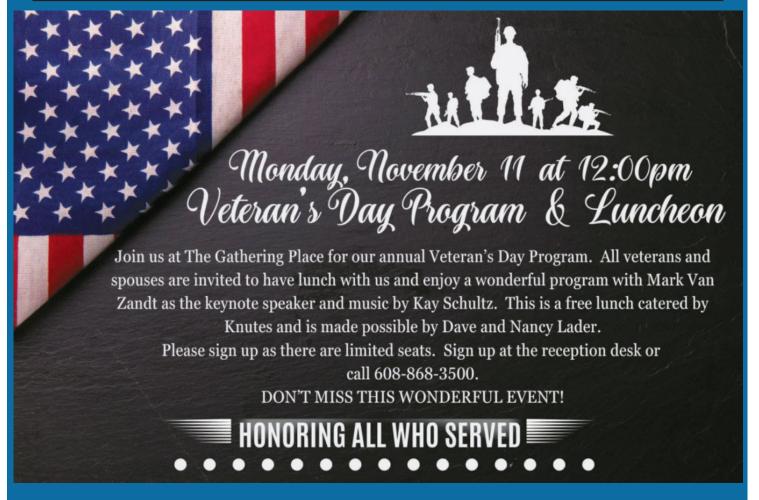
